

- 1 line for Tracks: House & monitors
- Diretc boxes X2: Stereo for keys, mono for bass
- Centre stage mics: Band has "T" top for double mics: SM57 for guitar talk-box

BACK LINE (when supplied by Purchaser):

- DRUM KIT: DW or PEARL (Pro Level only) Important: Must have "WHITE COATED HEADS"
 - 1. TOMS: 10" & 12" Rack Toms essential
 - FLOOR TOMS: 14" & 16" with legs. (if only one floor tom avail: 16")
 - 2. SNARE DRUMS: 14" main Snare, plus a 12" or 13" 2nd Snare for left side of Hi Hat (2 Snare stands required)
 - 3. CYMBALS: 20" Ride, 17" Crash, 18"Crash, 20" China: (2 extra boom stands required for extra equipment: Total of 6 Boom stands please)
 - 4. HI HAT CYMBALS: 2 sets of Hi Hats:
 - 14" Hats as Main, plus second set of 13" or 14" Hats (for XHat attachment Drummer supplies)
 - 5. HI HAT STAND: 2-legged adjustable Hi Hat stand (DW 9000 Preferred)
 - 6. FOOT PEDALS: DW 9000 or DW 5000 "DOUBLE" kick pedals (Please notify if *not* available!)
 - 7. DRUMSTOOL: Sturdy, adjustable, with back-rest
- GUITAR AMPS: Two amplifiers, per:
 - Mid-Stage Right and matching Mid-Stage Left (2)
 100-watt Marshalls: JCM900 pref or 2000 heads, 4X12 slant cabinets X2

 Only if both <u>not</u> avail: One Marshall & 1 Fender Deville: Tubes, no modelling amps
- **BASS AMP:** 400-watt minimum, in order of preference: GK 800RB, Ampeg, Trace Elliott, David Eden, SWR, Aguilar. Two 4X10" spkr cabs or one 8X10", same preference
- **KEYBOARD STAND:** Double "X" bracing, for single keyboard (band supplies keyboard)
- GUITAR STANDS: 4 single guitar stands, 1 double "T" guitar stand

To ensure the highest level of efficiency from performers and crew, Prism's dressingroom hospitality rider comprises the following:

Please provide:

- * A locked, secure non-smoking room with seating for five
 - * Access to a non-public washroom
 - * Hand towels (8)
 - * Mirror, AC power outlet(s)
 - * Trash can in room

Alcoholic Beverages:

- * Twelve (12) Corona beer
- * Twelve (12) Stella beer
- * Two (2) dry red wine: Merlot, Cabernet, Bordeaux etc

Non-Alcoholic Beverages:

- * One *non-alcohol* **white** grape wine:
 - Loxton champagne or Chardonnay avail at Safeway & Save-On
- * 24 bottled water, 1 litre Perrier Lime water
- * Soft drinks: i.e: soda water, ginger-ale, Coke, etc
- * Fruit juices: Assorted individual containers (IE: 450ml):
 Orange juice, unsweetened grapefruit juice, various: X12 minimum
